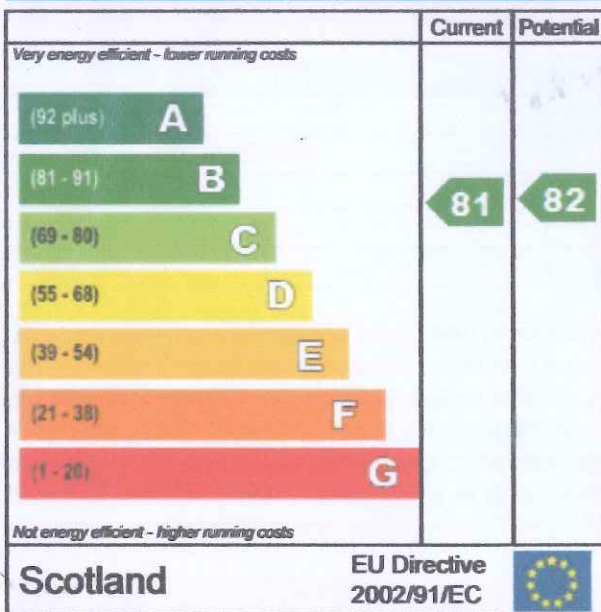

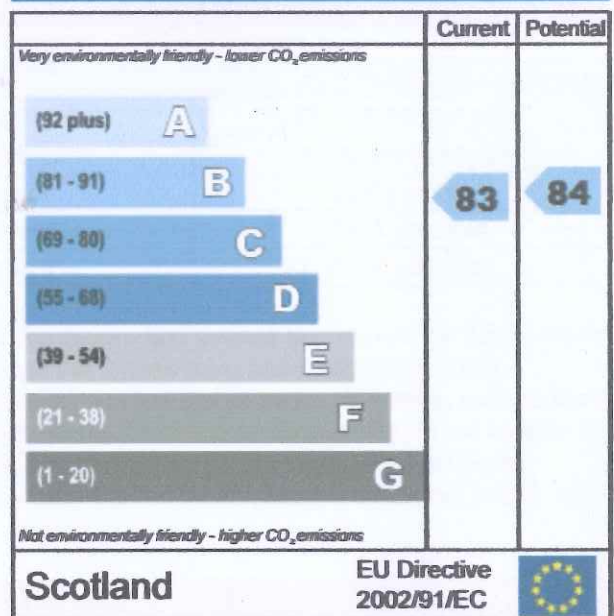
### Energy Efficiency Rating
