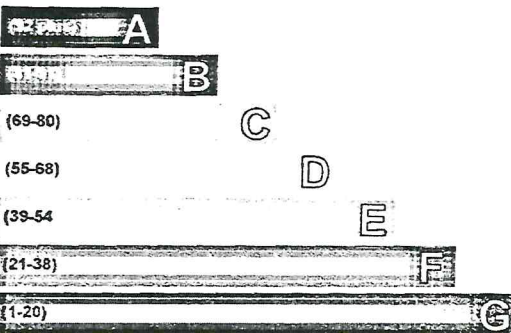

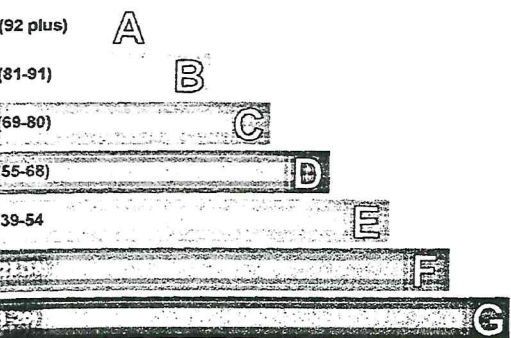
## Energy Efficiency Rating
